## The Poor Gain Access To Santa Cruz' Courts

That may be a little strong for James Popin and his staff of two attorneys, but they are doing something not done here before: bringing the law back to

The right to the services of a good attorney is an invaluable asset, worth more than it costs.

Even so, legal services cost too much in a nation founded on law and fair treatment in the courts; far too much for far too many people.

No wonder, then, that 1900 poor persons have come in the Legal Aid Society of Santa Cruz

County. The society is run by Popin and his staff under an Economic Opportnity Commission

grant. The organization has the sup-port of the County Bar Associa-tion, and over half the attorneys in town offer their services to the clients of the society, according to Popin. Though the attorneys don't charge, their time is figured as the one-fifth local share necessary to keep the \$80,000 EOC grant alive. Without local help, the federal

To be eligible for the legal aid service, a couple must make less than \$3000 per year, and not more than \$500 more for each child they have.


