A petition of the Marianist Province of the Pacific for a charter of incorporation was filed in the office of County Clerk H. E. Miller.

The Marianists have a school and seminary at ~~Chaminade~~ school near Santa Cruz.

The principal offices of the proposed corporation shall be at St. Louis College in Honolulu and the officers, until successors are chosen, are: Very Rev. Walter C. Tedkin, S. M. president; James P. Wipfield, S.M., vice president and treasurer; Rev. Joseph Sherry, S.M., second vice president; Harold Hammond, S. M., third vice president, and Rev. Leo A. Unt, S.M., secretary.

The members of the corporation shall be members of the society of Mary, an association working throughout the world in the interests of religion, charity and education, with headquarters at Nivelles, Belgium.
