"I've been trying to put my name on it," Laura said. "The store has my signature now."


She said the store has focused on both drawing a younger clientele and bringing the older, established customers back, and has succeeded on both counts.

popular children's classic tale that reflects the spring season. The store's colorful displays are one of its major drawing cards, Garcia said, and are built around "vignettes of color and scheme" that encourage customers to shop according to their desired theme.

From the Heart has been focusing considerable effort on its specialized gift baskets, which the store offers year-round. These can include a shower basket, filled with items from the store's baby department, or a bath and personal products basket, full of various offerings from the store's specialty collection of European lotions and bath salts, bath caviar, Camille Beckman products and other items. From the Heart staffers will help customers design a gift basket according to their theme or occasion, and their budget.

Laura is also particularly proud of the store's high-quality silk flowers and plants. The store also offers custom silk floral arrangements for any style or occasion. An entire section of the store is devoted to a showroom that features fine circa-1900 American Oak classic antique furniture offered by Felton-based O.J.'s American Antiques, produced by Beryl and Connie O'Brien, as well as Fred Miller's Antiques. The furniture has also proved very popular with the store's customers.

The store also offers an assortment of home décor items, including tapestries, wall sconces and hangings, lamps, candles and other beautiful gifts for the home.

From the Heart also prides itself on its selection of gourmet foods, ranging from dipping oils and balsamics to Double Devonshire and clotted cream imported from England, and dishware, which includes a brand new design each month.

From the Heart also offers a large selection of angels year-round.

In addition to its vast array of gift items and specialty products, From the Heart also offers home decorating and organizing classes, taught by store employee and designer Vanita Walters.
