

Contract Talks For Davis-Grunsky Grant Requested

Contract negotiations with the California Department of Water Resources for the Davis-Grunsky act recreation project at Newell Creek reservoir have been requested by City Water Director Weston Webber now that the two last obstacles have been successfully hurdled.

By yesterday's 3 to 1 voter endorsement of the \$1.3 million water revenue bond issue, some \$60,000 will be available so the city can match the state grant of \$149,300 for the project.

Monday, Lt. Gov. Glenn Anderson signed a bill eliminating a special election proviso of the Davis-Grunsky act which could have caused the city further delay and some \$3000 in election costs.
