

Schaffer Joins Planning Staff

James L. Schaffer, Capitola planning director and administrative assistant to Capitola City Manager Ryder Ray, has been hired as an associate planner by the City of Santa Cruz.

The announcement came from Santa Cruz Planning Director Neal Walton.

Schaffer, 27, has been planning director for Capitola since

January, 1967. He graduated from Watsonville High School and Cabrillo College and earned a degree in urban geography from Chico State College. He also has earned additional credits at the University of Santa Clara and UC Berkeley.

Schaffer, who is unmarried, will start with this city June 9. His primary duties, according to Walton, will be in planning

and zoning administration and as liaison to the public.

Schaffer replaces Jim McAloon, who resigned for reasons of health. The new planner's salary range is \$678-824.

His appointment still leaves a gap in the city planning staff. The post of associate planner has been vacant since Dave Armstrong resigned effective January 1 to enter private business.

Written examinations for four applicants, two from California and two from out of state, have been scheduled.
