# Off For A New Home



Yesterday was moving day at the old Santa Cruz County Courthouse on Cooper Street. A number of furnishings were carted out to be hauled away—not to the dump, but to be used again in an appropriate setting.

Several old desks, chairs, cabinets, bookcases and library tables will be used in the octagonal Hall of Records next door. The old roll-top desk in the photograph above—which had to be taken out a window under the sidewalk supervision of Supervisor Robert Burton, left, and Jerry Hughes, second from left—is destined for use in the Hall of Records, once the board of supervisors grants final approval.

On hand to check off the furnishings as they were removed were Hughes, county director of parks and recre-

ation; John Zehner, associate county administrator, and members of the Santa Cruz Historical Society.

The furnishings will be used jointly by Hughes and the society in the octagonal building, which will be Hughes' headquarters and site of the historical museum.

Among the more interesting items are two newspaper racks from the old law library; the measuring device used to determine voters'

heights when they registered; two judges' chairs and two poles with metal devices on the tip, used to open windows out of reach. The railing from Municipal court also may be used in the octagonal building.

Other furnishings will be sold at auction later, according to Zehner. In the meanwhile the preserved items will be stored, awaiting their new home in the Hall of Records.
