# New Church Construction Begins

Another new church structure is going up in Santa Cruz.

Ground-breaking ceremonies were conducted Sunday afternoon at the site of the new building of the Neighborhood Church of the Christian and Missionary Alliance at 221 Rooney street.

Some 75 persons were on hand to view the official beginnings of the building expected to be completed in approximately four months by Contractor Paul Baker.

Greetings from the city were brought by Mayor Adrian Jensen followed by a talk by Rev. Elmer Podoll, president of the Santa Cruz Ministerial fellowship and pastor of Grace Methodist church.

Rev. James Oliver, pastor of Trinity Presbyterian church, gave appropriate readings from the Scriptures. The congregation of the Missionary and Alliance church has been assembling temporarily in the Trinity church building.

The prayer of dedication and main talk of the afternoon was presented by Rev. W. V. Yaggy of Glendale, superintendent of the South Pacific district, Missionary and Alliance churches.

The benediction was given by Pastor Frank S. Sutherland.

Accompanied by an electric organ, Dr. Herbert G. Tovey of Santa Cruz Bible House sang "Others."
