Federal funds will pay for West Cliff damage

SANTA CRUZ — Wave damage to West Cliff Drive, estimated at \$182,000, will be repaired at no cost to the city, Public Works Director Larry Erwin said Tuesday.

He told City Councilmembers that federal funds will cover all of the damage that waves and high tide caused in this winter's storms.

The drive's pedestrian path has been lost in a number of places and in three spots between David Way and Columbia Street, the ocean is endangering the roadway.

The council hired Granite Construction to repair the damage with rock and other fill material. Contract was set at \$182,000.
