

Future in doubt

Governmental wheels have been set in motion to try and save the Valencia Farm Bureau Center building, in front of which Mr. and Mrs. Don Galbraith are standing. It was built on the banks of Bear Creek at Valencia and Bear Valley Roads in the 1880s, primarily as a dining hall for loggers. The Farm Center, of which Galbraith is president, was given the building in 1933, but not the land

under it. The new owner of the land, John Newell of Mountain View, wants the building moved or demolished by the end of January. Supervisor Dale Dawson will meet tomorrow with other county officials to see what can be done to save the old building which has seen continuous use since it was built. Galbraith said the building is too fragile to move, and should be preserved at the present location for its historical value.
