

\$40,000 offered for wharf sculpture

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SANTA CRUZ — In the arts community here, the \$40,000 question is what sculptor's work will be selected to grace the Municipal Wharf.

That's the size of the prize being offered by the Santa Cruz Arts Commission.

The panel is seeking a "significant piece of sculpture" for the entrance to the wharf, which is being redesigned to install street lights and other improvements, and to eliminate the parking meters which wharf visitors find annoying.

The project began a month ago under a \$1.5 million contract with B and B Construction of San Jose.

Only Santa Cruz County sculptors are eligible.

Those interested are asked to submit three to five slides of previous work, including at least one piece of outdoor sculpture, a resume, and a self-addressed stamped envelope.

The deadline is 3 p.m. Jan. 24. Materials should be sent to the Santa Cruz Arts Commission, 307 Church St., Santa Cruz, Calif. 95060.
