Deer Park still stalled

The Deer Park shopping center in Rio del Mar lost the first round of its battle with the coastal commission Monday.

Commissioners, 9-5, decided the shopping center is a development of several separate buildings, rather than one independent complex.

This means that applications for each of the center will have to be submitted to the coastal commission for the permit, rather than having the whole center be considered at once.

The first hearings are expected in early June.

Deer Park, a \$3 million complex, has been under construction for several months, but recently was the subject of a stop-work order from the coast commission.

Although it had been approved by the county of Santa Cruz, Deer Park fell into the coastal zone on Jan. 1.
