


A Sunny Afternoon At A UC Regents' Meeting

A group of UCSC students march between residence halls at Merrill College on


their way to Crown College where UC Regents were meeting yesterday.




All was not protest yesterday at UCSC. After the Board of Regents' meeting adjourned, there was some cooperation in the meeting room.
