



Three years later

Coming back

Three years to the day after the Loma Prieta earthquake so damaged his church that it must be rebuilt, the Rev. Mike Miller stands in front of the shell of St. Patrick's Church Saturday (above) for a reading from the Bible (held by Gregory Giron) shortly before mass was held in the Notre Dame gymnasium, the temporary home of the church. Meanwhile, in Santa Cruz, a huge crane was lifting the steeple, dislodged by the big quake, onto its accustomed spot atop Holy Cross Church (left), once again creating a landmark visible from miles around.
