

# 17 Projects In Capitola Improvements Program

Seventeen different projects are listed in the capital improvements program for county buildings in the report released Friday by County Administrative Officer Ed Hane.

The program will be considered tomorrow by the board of supervisors.

The projects and their costs are as follows:

**1. New courthouse complex in San Lorenzo Park redevelopment project, \$3.9 million. Completion date under pay-as-you-go financing is 1968.**

In fiscal 1963-64, the courthouse fund will have \$1,256,000. Adding \$500,000 yearly from sales tax, using \$376,307 in the juvenile hall fund, getting \$319,000 from the federal government to pay half share of an emerg-

ency operation center (civil defense), the total will be reached in 1968.

**2. New juvenile hall, \$480,000.** With the \$376,307 formerly earmarked for a hall "frozen" for such use by the November "courthouse first" initiative election, no building funds can be used for the hall until a courthouse is completed. Hane recommends the \$376,307 go into courthouse construction costs and suggests a special tax be levied to gain hall money.

**3. Repairs of Front street annex, \$1150.**

**4. New boiler in annex, \$2164.**

**5. Installation of fire escape in annex, \$5000.** Money already is available.

**6. Garage and maintenance center, \$35,000.**

**7. Covered ramp at county hospital, \$6400.**

**8. Emergency generator at hospital, \$13,000.**

**9. Remodeling at hospital, \$6000.**

**10. New hospital kitchen, \$300,000.**

**11. New hospital laundry unit, \$300,000.**

**12. Repairs at health center, \$500.**

**13. Health center parking area, \$1900.**

**14. Parking area at county office of education at 1010 Fair avenue, \$500.**

**15. Agricultural extension service office, \$5000.**

**16. Law library in Watsonville area, \$10,000.**

**17. Honor farm, \$125,000.**
