
Almost finished 1-23-40 W-P

Unofficially, the word is that the Highway 1 bridges over Struve Slough outside Watsonville, which were closed to traffic since they collapsed in the earthquake, may be completed in a week. A Caltrans spokesman said today there was still about a week's worth of work to

be done on the project, although the official reopening date is still set at March 1. The new north- and southbound bridges are each 500 feet long. Crews have been working around the clock since November on the \$5.1 million project.
