Miss Marion Hollins, former national women's golf champion, who has announced that she will seek her former laurels at Los Angeles next summer.

The former New York star, who heads the syndicate behind the Pasatiempo Golf Club property at Santa Cruz, has been practicing over the course with Angel de La Torre, the Argentine pro she engaged as club professional, and is reported to be shooting in the seventies.

Miss Hollins, five times holder of the Pebble Beach title, may decide to go abroad in the spring for the British women's tourney. She reached the semi-finals in the 1929 championship.
