

Peace March Arrives In Santa Cruz

Members of the World Peace March arrived in the Santa Cruz area today and will be visiting sites throughout the county Saturday to heighten awareness about the nuclear arms race and to focus attention on the upcoming United Nations second special session on disarmament.

The marchers are en route from San Diego to Bangor, Wash., homeport of the Trident nuclear submarine. This afternoon, they were scheduled to meet with city officials at City Hall where a mayor's

proclamation of welcome was to be presented.

On Saturday, marchers will be at the Resource Center for Non-violence, 515 Broadway, at 10 a.m., at the east field house at UCSC at 12:30 p.m. and at the Lockheed Missiles and Space facility on Empire Grade Road for a vigil at 3 p.m.

Potluck dinners for the marchers will be at the center tonight at 7:30 and Saturday at 5:30 p.m.
