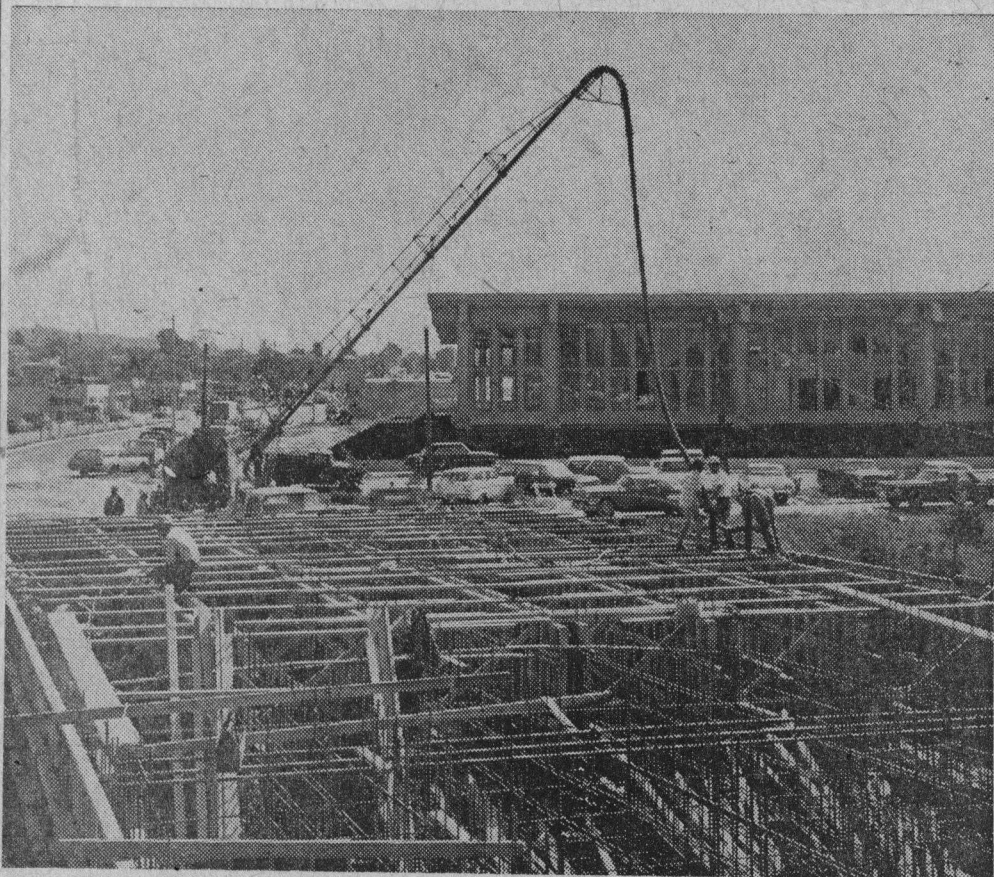


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## First Cement Pour For Water Street Bridge



Ninety cubic yards of concrete — 182 tons — were pumped into these forms yesterday in the first major “pour” on the Water Street bridge widening project. The

concrete will form one of the piers supporting the expansion which will widen the roadway to four, and ultimately six, traffic lanes. The project, originally slated for com-

pletion in September, has been delayed by heavy rains, probably until November. The new Laurel street bridge is expected to be complete about the same time.
