The commission also approved an additional 290 lineal feet of the interlocking steel sheet piling for the east side of the harbor Tuesday. It will be in the marine repair area.

Total cost of the change orders will be about \$100,000.

usable land area.

Ralph Ring, district director, said special arrangements are be-ing worked out for massed winter berthing for commercial fishing

vessels. "We want to come up with something so they wont have to pay the same rate as if they were

in a slip," Ring said.

The commission set a May 21 deadline for deposits on the 320 slips proposed for the harbor. After that, a waiting list of more than 70 boat owners will that, a waiting list than 70 boat owners will be contacted.

"The deposits are coming in especially well from out of town. We hope local people who have asked for reservations will not procrastinate and get aced out, Ring said.
