Deer Park Item On Friday Zoner Agenda

Seventy-nine items face the County Zoning Administrator Friday, including requests for an additional office at Deer Park development, a compost shed for a mushroom plant, and a retail store in the Capitola area.

The zoner meets with applicants and the public beginning at 9 a.m. in room 400N of the county center.

Major items include:

— Cabrillo Investment Co. for Carl N. Swensen Co. requests an amendment to its use permit at Deer Park, Rio Del Mar area, to allow a free-standing real estate office to be

built. Hearing after 10 a.m.

— Ifland Engineers is asking for the Twin Lakes Baptist Church a permit to build a 3,750 square foot steel building for a bus shelter; this item to come after 11 a.m.

— Also after 11 a.m., a request by West Foods Inc. to build a storage shed for compost for a mushroom plant at 2585 Hillcrest Ave. will be heard. — Barry Ginochio is requesting a permit to operate a contractor's storage yard, north of 1055 17th Ave.

—Wallie B. Kaufmann requests a permit to build a retail store at 1025 Capitola Road.
