

Aptos parade set

The Aptos Ladies Tuesday Evening Society will have a banner after all for the 16th Annual Parade.

Thanks to the overwhelming generosity of many citizens and businesses a brand new banner will be floating across the street in the Village again this year.

However, it must be stressed that the Parade does not start in the Village. It will, instead, form at the Wells Fargo Bank at the corner of State Park Drive and Soquel Dr. at noon on the 4th and march down to the new Aptos Village Park.

The Park is located just over the railroad tracks on the road leading to Nisene Marks State Park. There are many open fields for parking but the wise will arrive early.

The booths will start serving food at noon just one hour before parade time. Visitors to the parade are urgently

requested to make provision for removal of their own trash along the parade route especially from the Rancho Del Mar Shopping Center to the bridge.

The Cabrillo Lions have volunteered to take charge of trash removal but it will only be by individual help in this that the Ladies will get another parade permit. It was an iffy situation in 1976 and a warning came from the board of supervisors that if rubbish is found on July 5 of this year, it just might possibly be that last parade.

The antique cars will be on display before the parade in the parking lot at Wells Fargo Bank and leave the parade just before entering the park. They generally start to arrive about 11 a.m. so antique car buffs should come about that time.
