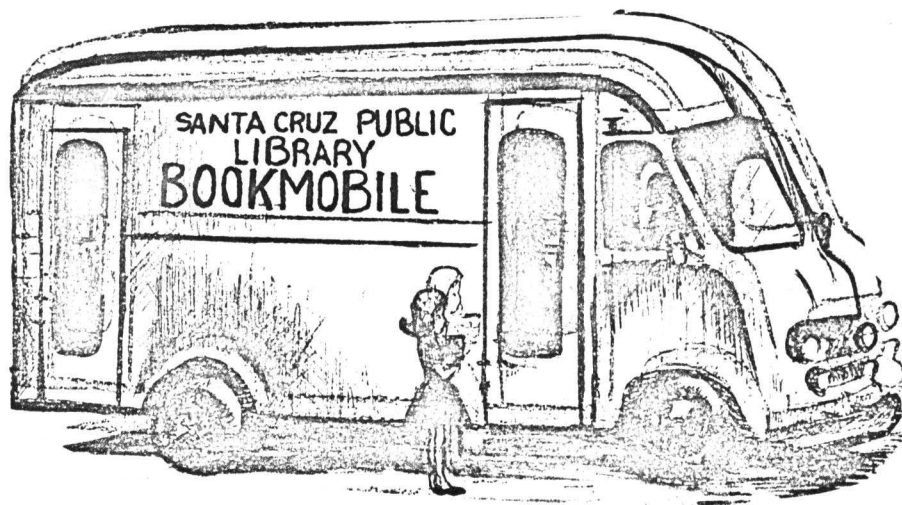

BOOKMOBILE PURCHASED

The City Council has approved the purchase of a \$15,405 Bookmobile scheduled for February delivery. It is to be manufactured by the Gerstenslager Company, Wooster, Ohio. The Mobile Library will be 16 feet in length, powered by an 8 cylinder Dodge engine, and fully equipped with shelving for 2,400 volumes.
