Lloyd's Tire Service closes Freedom shop

Owner: Santa Cruz County business to focus on Santa Cruz location

The South County branch of Lloyd's Tire Service has closed its doors after more than six years at 2025 Freedom Blvd.

Owner Larry Johnson cited lackluster sales as the main reason for the closure.


"We enjoyed being in Freedom; it just didn't grow as expected," he said.

At the Santa Cruz branch, which has been in business since 1940 and at its present location for 50 years, business is booming, Johnson said.

"We're growing and expanding and doing very well," he said.

Johnson said the company is expanding its business at the Santa Cruz branch, adding one bay and introducing a "quick lube" service for sameday oil changes.
