It looks like Santa Cruz County's first indoor public swimming pool will soon be built in Live Oak.

County officials are working with the Live Oak school district to build a recreation and aquatics center and middle school on about 21 acres off 17th Avenue. The project could be completed in two to three years, said county and school district officials.

County Parks Director Ben Angove said the pool would be the only one of its kind in the county. Other indoor pools are privately owned, such as by spas, he said.

"We see this as the major public resource for pools," Angove said. "We think it's going to get a lot of use and a Midcounty location is perfect."
