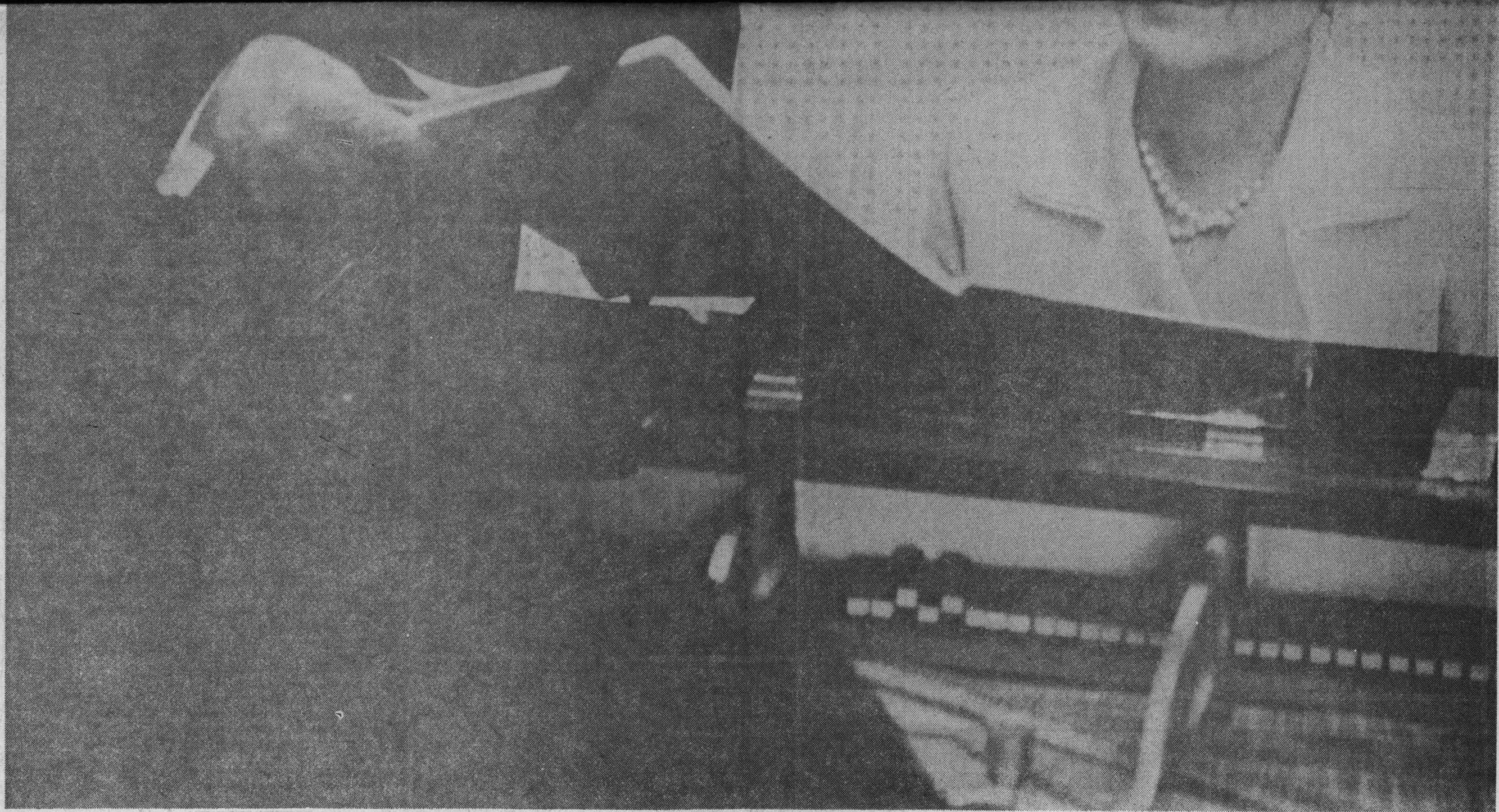

Music at Cabrillo

It has become a tradition in the relatively short period of 11 years — the Cabrillo Music Festival.

A tradition that brings some of the finest in classical and contemporary music to a small county that counted itself "cultured" 123 years ago to have one piano within its boundaries.

This year's 11th annual Festival will include eight concerts on the weekends of August 17-19 and 24-26.

Festival conductor Carlos Chavez is here for his fourth season. Concert pianist Teresa Rodriguez is here for her third. Above, they confer at the piano.

On opening night Miss Rodriguez will play Brahms's Second Concerto; for the second weekend of the festival she will play Berg's Four Pieces for Clarinet and Piano. Clarinetist Donald O'Brien will join her. She is here for the Festival following tours in South America, Europe and her native Mexico.

Conductor Chavez has a long list of honors and credits and is known internationally for his compositions as well as his conducting.
