On Predonating Blood

The gift of blood is often life-saving. But increased awareness that blood can transmit serious illness has led to a new apprehension about receiving transfusions. A misplaced fear of contracting AIDS has kept, even though current blood screening methods have been

shown to be safe. The procedure is simple in concept--yet somehow difficult in practice. At least that was the conclusion of a recent survey conducted at 18 medical centers. Among patients who underwent elective surgery in these hospitals, only 59 of those considered eligible to predonate blood actually did so. Yet of those who did transfuse, 1,000,000
