Blue and gold welcome to UCSC

The University of California is being welcomed to Santa Cruz with flowers. The Santa Cruz Garden club and the department of parks and recreation of Santa Cruz are jointly sponsoring a Spring Flower Show at the Harvey West Park clubhouse, May 21-22. The show theme is "Welcome to Santa Cruz University of California with your Blue and Gold."

Blue and gold flowers will dominate the exhibits and one feature display will be a six by twenty foot sign, "Welcome UCSC". The letters will be gold flowers and the background a sea of blue flowers. Blue and gold flower combinations will be found in flower arrangements and cut flowers. Other exhibits will include Rhododendrons, Azaleas, Irises, Gloxinias, roses, day lilies, new hybrid Pelargoniums and many annuals.

Doors open at 2 p.m. and close at 8 p.m. each day.

Carl Bengston, director of city parks and recreation, will act as master of ceremonies for the show opening program of speakers on Saturday, May 21st at 2 p.m. in Harvey West Park clubhouse.

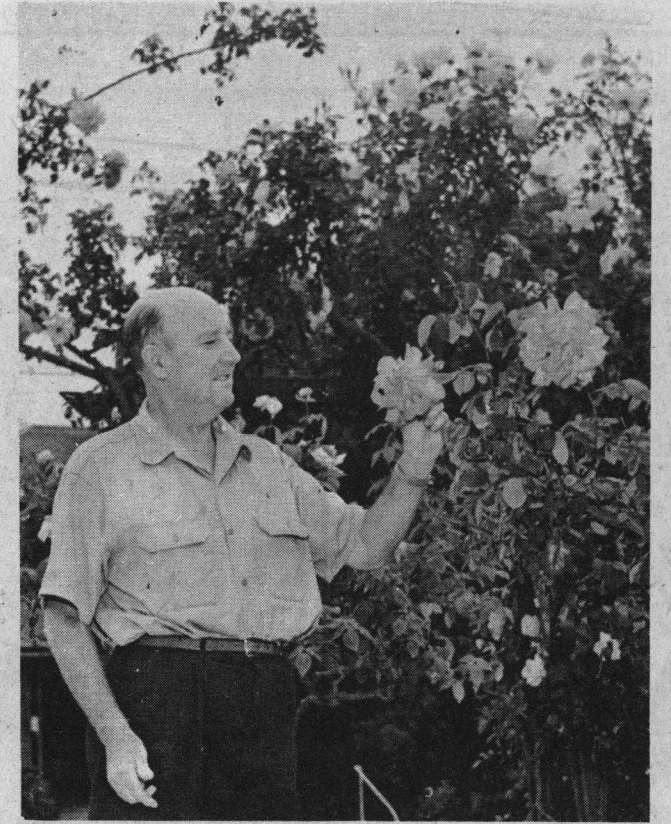
