President Johnson has accepted a United Nations True Proposal! To reinforce this step—march with us on Saturday. Our concern is immediate!

The *Committee For Responsibility* has shown concern for napalm-burned children, in their proposal to bring the wounded and the maimed to the United States for treatment. We must stop burning children; think of the incredible number of children we will be responsible for if the war continues for ten or fifteen years, according to the predictions of military experts. (Remember the claim that we would be out of Vietnam by 1965?)

Look at the youngster in your home or the home next door. We owe it to these as-yet-unmarked children to do *everything* to secure their future, free from war.

THINK THROUGH YOUR ANSWERS TO THESE QUESTIONS:

1. We have spent over twenty billion dollars in waging the war since we helped the French fail there. What if this had been invested in protecting the South Vietnamese in the enclaves suggested by Republican and Democrat experts, helping them solve their land reform problems?
2. Would not the other emerging nations have been irresistibly attracted to our way of life? Would not the former allies we're losing have stayed with us? (Instead, 80% of the world's press criticizes our bombings.)
3. Remembering how the Vietnamese have feared the Chinese for generations, would they have turned to us or to China for guidance?
4. If we are the only important police power in the world, spending two million per hour in Vietnam, why didn't we police the military juntas in Brazil, and elsewhere?
5. Is the word "Communism" feared more than "Colonialism" in Asia?
6. Why didn't we go through the United Nations as with Korea, where we gained instead of lost allies? (We're coming around to that Now, after 5,000 Americans dead and 300,000 Vietnamese! "How many times," the song wants to know.)
