

May Decide On Employes' Wage Status

City councilmen must elect a mayor of Santa Cruz during tonight's meeting of the group in the city hall.

The charter provides that a mayor must be elected by the council at its second regular meeting in April.

Any one member of the city council is eligible for election, and there is no rule against re-election of the current mayor. Councilmen Sam C. McNeely and George N. Penniman have both served as mayors. Charles M. Brunjes is assistant mayor. Other members are William Davenport, Patrick J. Freeman, and Cliff Dysle. Jack L. Chiorini has served as mayor for the past year.

Also due to be discussed at this evening's meeting is the question of employes' salaries, and the council is expected to announce its decision regarding the recommendations for increases made to it during past meetings.
