Santa Cruzans Pay Tribute To Former City Manager Klein

Santa Cruz business and civic leaders gave an honestly emotional and warmly humorous farewell to City Manager Robert Klein and his family yesterday during a tribute luncheon at the Palomar hotel.

The luncheon was sponsored by the chamber of commerce and attended by some 140 persons who came to say goodbye to the man who in five years has radically changed the face and temper of the community.

Former mayor and City Councilman Paul Forgey emceed an hour and a half series of quips, barbs, praise and words of regret given by former mayors, business leaders, city employees, a state legislator and Klein's own wife, Chris.

Klein takes over tomorrow as the \$22,500-a-year chief administrator of Fresno, thus becoming that city's first manager.

As roughly two dozen persons took the floor to praise Klein's achievements, they eased some of the emotional tension by referring to his driving (usually at 90 m.p.h. and considered a sure cure for any passenger's hiccups), whirlwind pace on the job, golf and bridge games.

As he was presented with a chamber board of directors' resolution of appreciation and a movie camera, Klein rose, admitted to being embarrassed and frankly looked it.

"I think I am claiming much of the credit here which really belongs to the persons who are giving it" he said.

"In the years I have been here the community has shown itself that the prophets of doom are wrong and that progress can come to Santa Cruz.

"Without vision a community

will perish. Because Santa Cruz has that vision it makes me unimportant by comparison."

Mayor Adrian Jensen pointed out that in Klein's five years in office, the city has embarked on flood control, parking lots, redevelopment, park expansion, sewer system and dozens of other projects.

Former Mayor Cliff Dysle said, "The only thing which prevented Bob from doing more for the city was that the council refused to give him any more money."

Former Mayor George Penniman summed up the feelings of a majority of the crowd and possibly the community when he stated:

"Our city will never be the same again. And it is a fortunate thing for the city."

Besides the speeches, the Harmony Belles made up of three sisters, harmonized the refrain. The girls are Chris, Mary and Ann Marie Huddleston of 705 Modesto avenue.
