William Scaroni, Coast Dairyman, Died Yesterday

William Scaroni, 63, long time coast dairyman, died yesterday in a local nursing home after a long illness.

For many years he operated the Eagle Glen Dairy at 5021 Coast road. The family also operated a cheese plant for a number of years and were well known cheesemakers.

Scaroni was the son of the late Victor Scaroni, who died in 1932 and Massissma Scanara Scaroni, who died in 1906.

He was a native of Lompoc, but the family moved to their Coast ranch about 60 years ago. He was a member of the Holy Cross church.

He is survived by two brothers, John and Arnold Scaroni and two sisters, Miss Kate Scaroni and Mrs. Virginia Meehan, all of Santa Cruz.
