

The Chairman Views Campus Master Plan



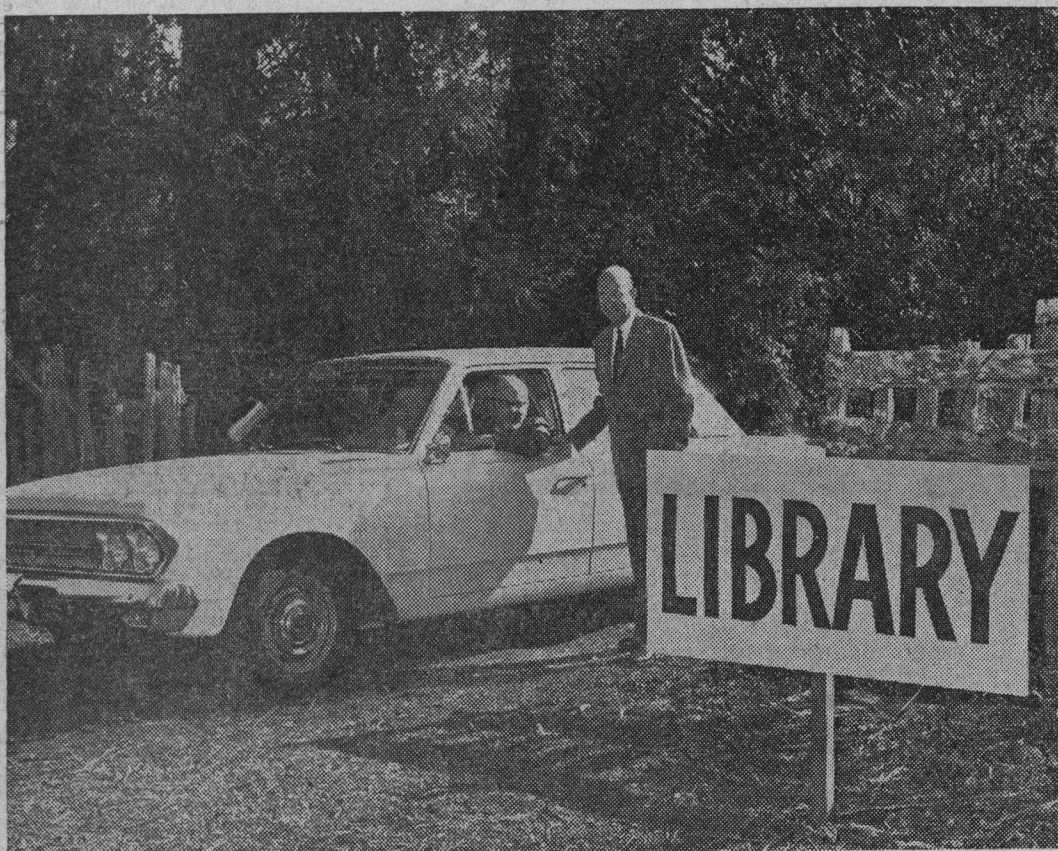
Chairman Gerald Hagar of the University of California Board of Regents holds a map
