

Library agreement OK'd by county

An agreement for local volunteers to run the Ben Lomond Community Library under the umbrella of the San Lorenzo Valley Youth Council has been approved by the county Board of Supervisors.

The agreement calls for the library to be run by Friends of the Ben Lomond Library, a component of the Youth Council. The council is responsible for providing personnel, and for cleaning and maintaining the library.

The county will pay for gas and electricity, and for parts and supplies for building maintenance, according to the agreement.

A system to collect and deliver books from other Santa Cruz City and county libraries is still to be arranged, according to terms of the agreement.

The Library was scheduled for closure earlier this year until volunteers stepped in to take over the Mill Street operation.
