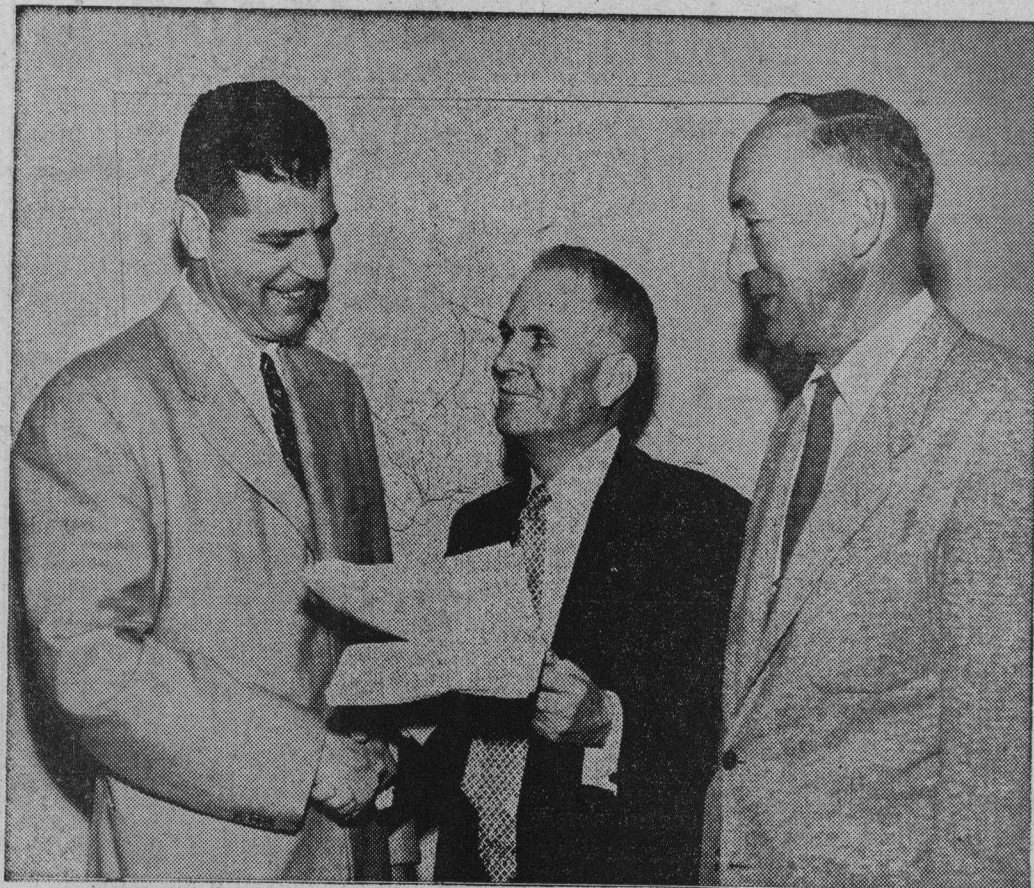

FCDA Office In Santa Cruz Closes

ing for federal flood repair funds since the Christmas flood. McAnally's office approved requests totalling \$837,000 from local governments from San Mateo to San Luis Obispo counties. This included \$166,

335 for the city of Santa Cruz and \$270,575 for the county. The money is for repair of public facilities — roads, bridges and buildings — damaged by flood waters. McAnally will return to his post at FCDA headquarters in Battle Creek, Mich.
