
City Hall Addition Slowed



Construction of Santa Cruz' new city hall addition, now 15 to 20 per cent complète, is running behind schedule due to the drenching rains that have halted work repeatedly during recent weeks. Pre-cast walls lying flat in the above photo will be raised into place to form the two-story building. The first

floor will house the city's finance department and water department administrative offices. The second floor will hold the public works, inspection and planning departments. All city offices will be moved from the municipal auditorium. The police department will move

into the north wing of the current city hall building, and the west wing will house the city manager, personnel and council offices. Cost of the new 15,000-square-foot addition, located directly behind the present city hall, is \$450,000. It is expected to be finished by January 1, 1968.
