July 10, City Water ment Director Weston Webber testified for two hours to show cause why an Earlier superior court order giving Mrs. Bartlett free water was not carried out.

After taking testimony, Superior Judge Gilbert Perry continued the case until Thursday when Attorney Charles Leib of San Jose will defend the city and At-torney Robert Bennett will

argue for the Bartlett interests.

The city argues the old Branciforte line users still have their rights from the main but the city refuses to continue maintenance. The line was abandoned because of high maintenance costs. A parallel line was laid which former users could connect to, but without the former free water rights. Bennett earlier stated that the

city is still obligated to furnish the free water in part because of the riparian water rights deeded over to the city when the Branci-forte line was taken into the city's system to take advantage of the Happy Valley dam source.
