TWO-MASTER Augustine of Saratoga is ownof the most unusual ship to be berthed at Santa Cruz yacht harbor, a square-rigged, two master that can rightfully be termed the "smallest brig-type ship in the world." The 22-foot long craft displaces at 1.5 tons, and uses 386 square-feet of sail under full sail. The "Dubble Eagle" was designed and built by its owner and took four years to build. It was built in the back yard of Augustine's Saratoga home. built in 1856 and had a displacement of 2.3 tons.
