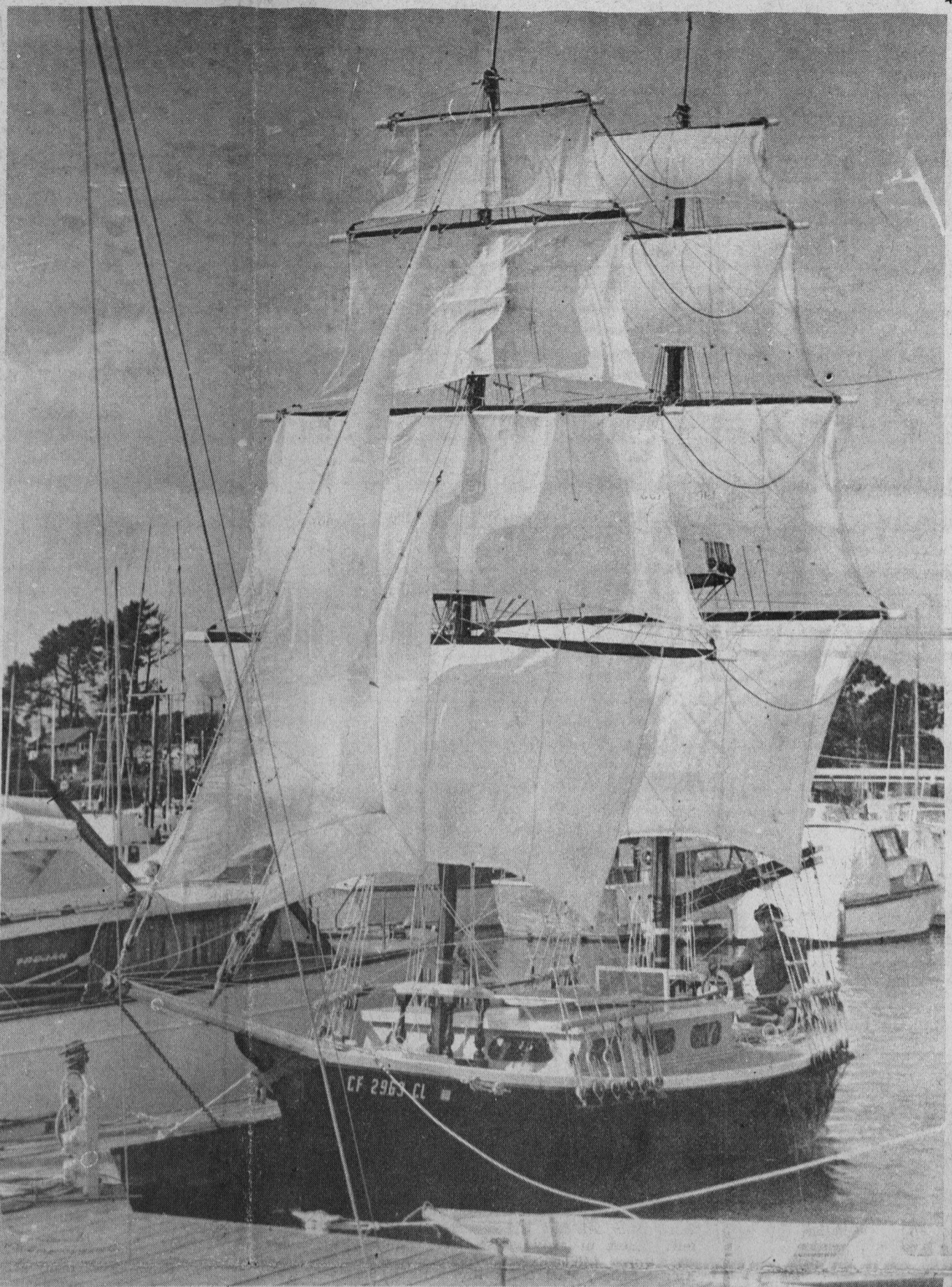


*Littlest 'Brig' in the World at Santa Cruz*



**TWO-MASTER -- F. W. Augustine of Saratoga is owner of the most unusual ship to be berthed at Santa Cruz yacht harbor, a square-rigged, two master that can rightfully be termed the "smallest brig-type ship in the world."**

The 22-foot long craft displaces at 1.5 tons, and uses 386 square-feet of sail under full sail. The "Dubble Eagle" was designed and built by its owner and took four years to build. It was built in the backyard of Augustine's Saratoga home.

The next smallest brig was built in 1856 and had a displacement of 2.3 tons.

Although he can rig canvas and set sail in around 5 minutes alone he finds a crew of two makes for an easier cruise -- News Photos.
