
What is taking up the vacuum? Mac Slides.

The latest mania to hit the U.S. is a 32-foot high, 163-foot long slide on which riders attain speeds up to 32 miles per hour over three thrilling drops.


The craze is spreading out from Southern California, where most of the modern fads and fancies seem to originate these days.
