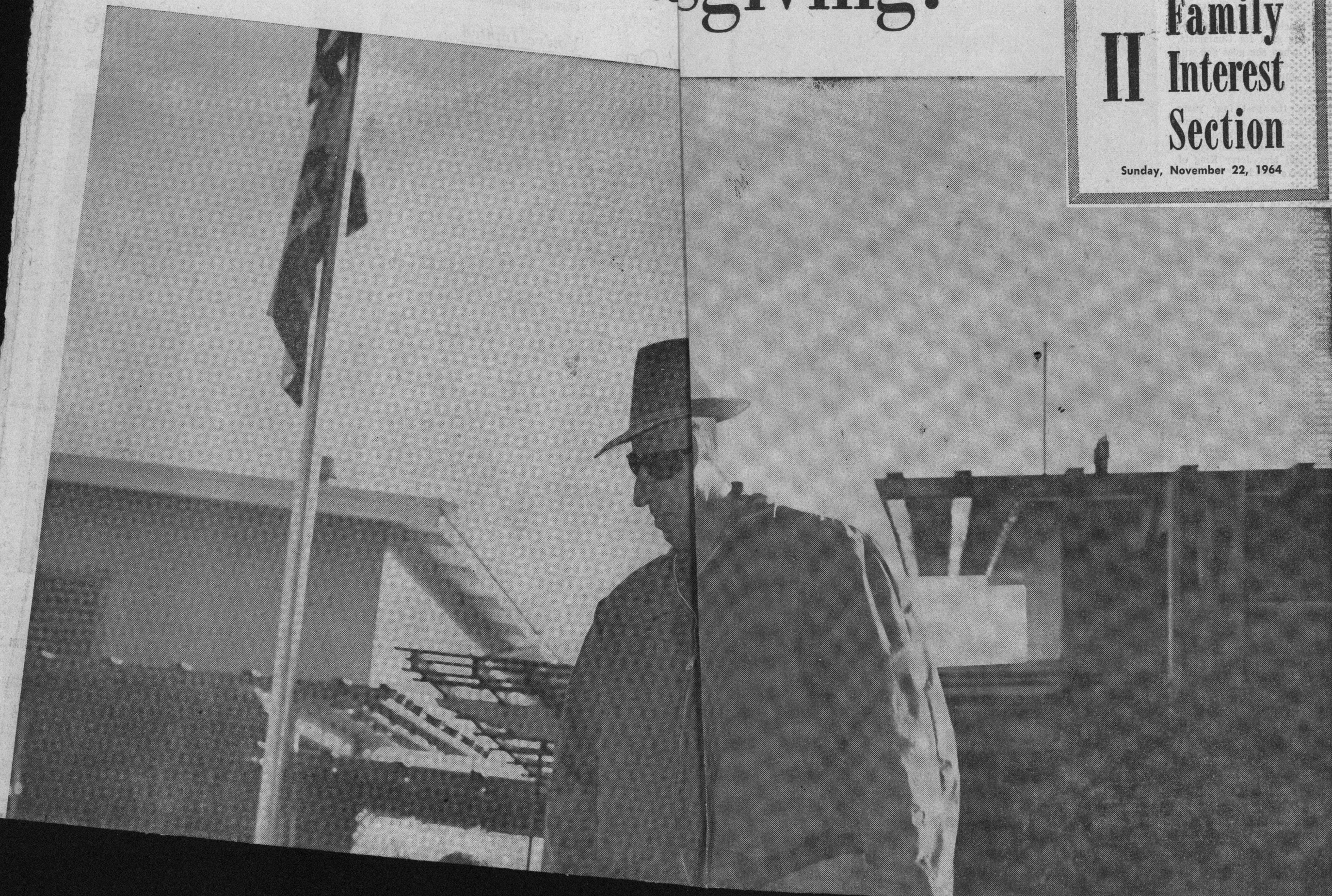


What Is Thanksgiving?
