

# **Park project to start**

Groundbreaking ceremonies will be held Friday at 2 p.m., for the new community center building in the Aptos village park.

The building will be built with donated labor by members of the Cabrillo Lions Club, with materials being purchased by a \$25,000 grant from the county board of supervisors.

The Aptos Village Park property was originally acquired by the county public works department as the right-of-way for the Aptos village bypass road. Three years ago, the county repurchased the land as a park site and has been slowly developing the site since.

The park is located on the east side of Aptos Creek, behind the Pop-Inn, with access off the Hopkins right-of-way.

When completed, the 2,000-square-foot building will contain a small kitchen, meeting room and restrooms. Another 1,000-square-feet will be covered on the outside of the building.
