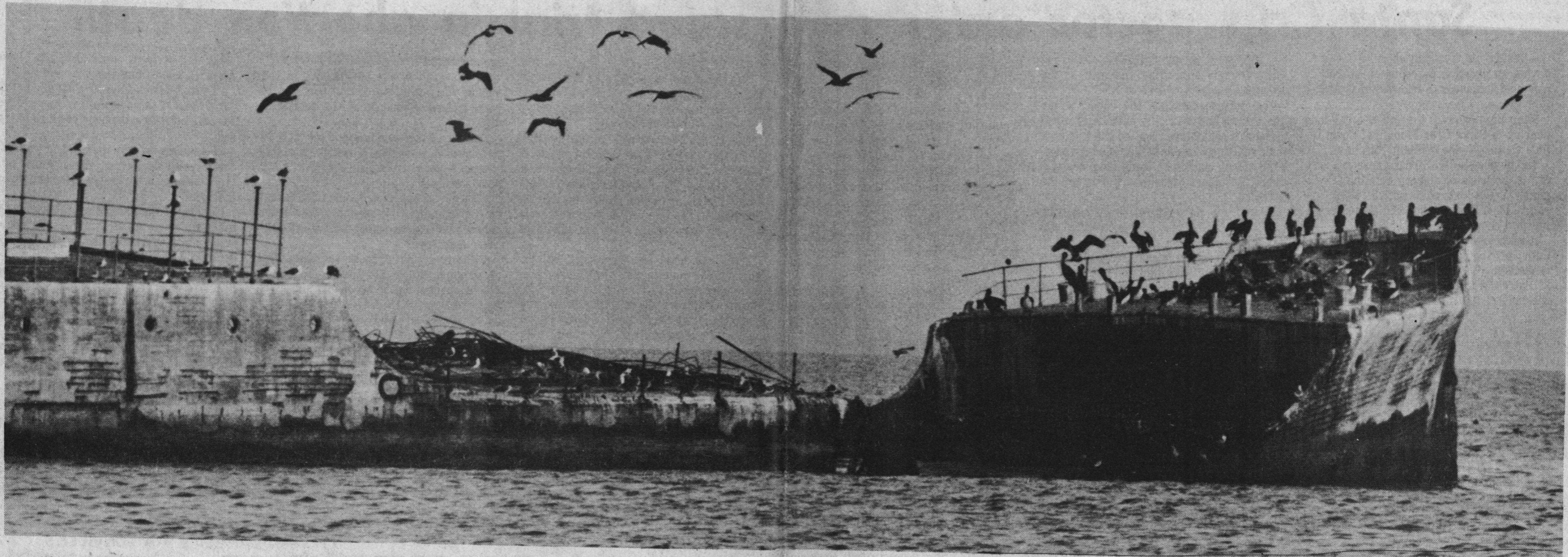
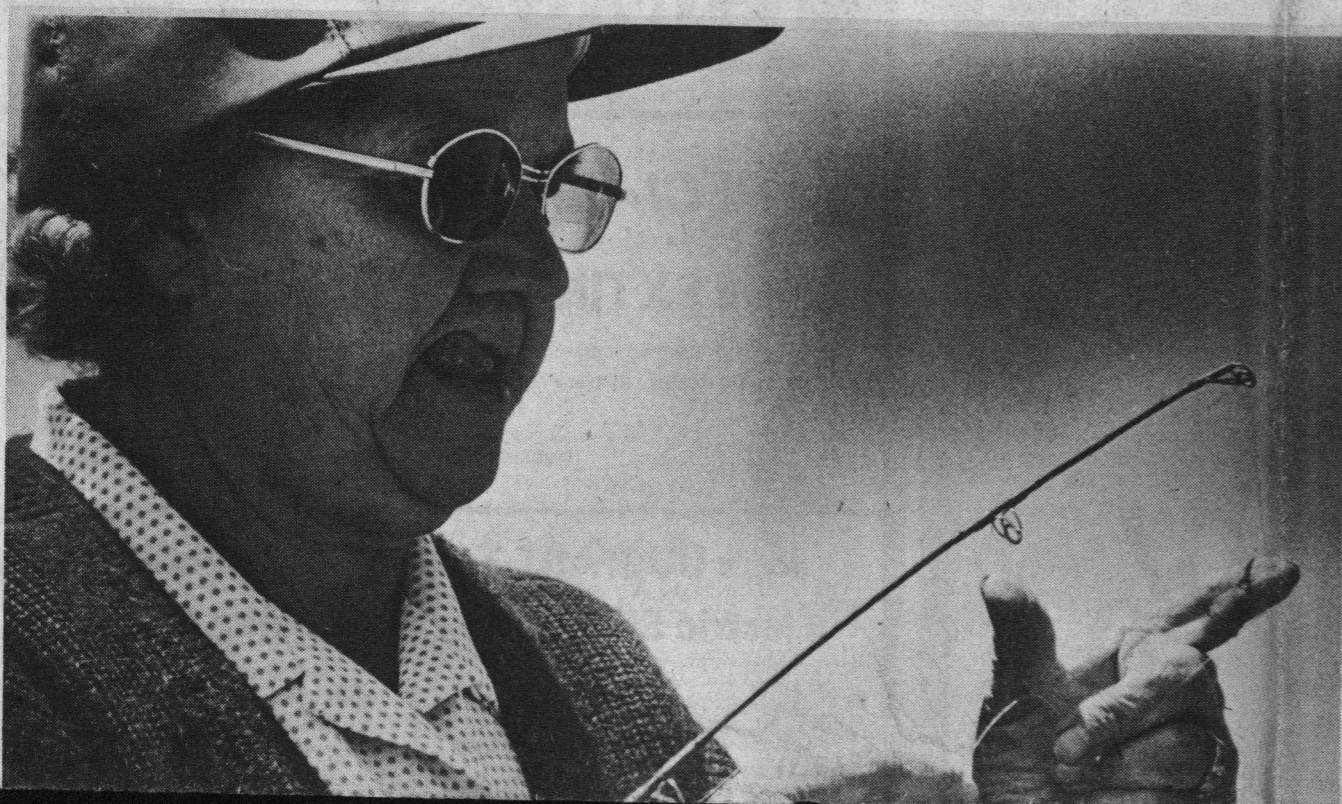


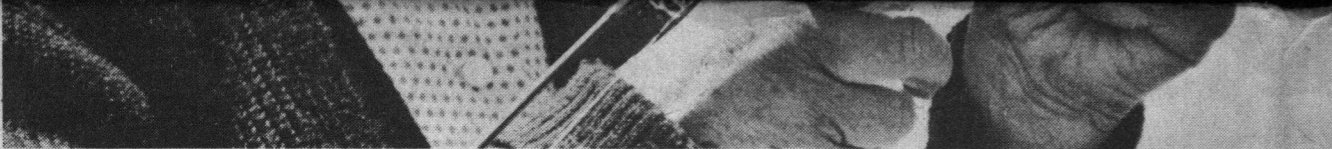

Sean (left) and Shane Bradshaw of Austin, Texas spend the day fishing for salmon and kingfish.

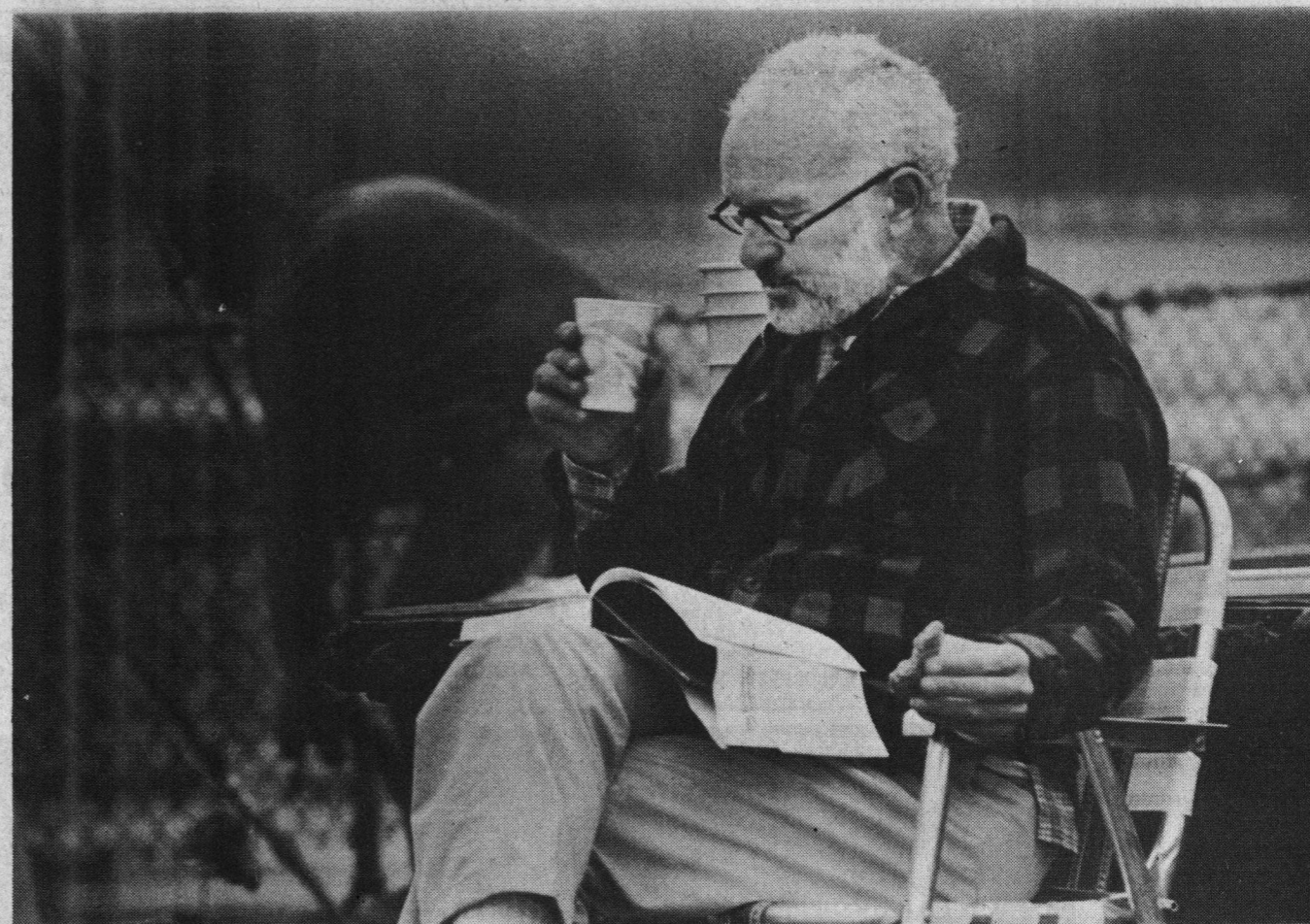
