A Tree Goes Into New Home



A huge tree-moving machine dumps a five-ton tree, top photo, into its new resting place in the new governmental center parking area near Water street. The 50-foot long, 30,000-pound tree mover is owned by Arnaz Enterprises of Mountain View. Some 42 trees, mostly pines and redwoods, will be moved by the machine. Over 150 trees of various types are part of the landscaping for the \$6.7-million center. Most of the trees will come from volunteer donors and organizations willing to pay the moving cost. Supervisor Russ McCallie "supervises" county governmental center inspector Bill Shaffer as he shovels dirt to stabilize a newly-planted tree in the parking lot.
