

List Of Capital Improvements Proposed By SC Committee

Following is the list of capital improvements recommended for the 1965-66 fiscal year by the citizens' advisory committee of the capital improvement program for Santa Cruz. The list shows the proposed improvement, its cost and source of funds, indicated as follows: GO, general obligation bonds; GF, general fund; A, assessment district; GT, gas tax funds; R, revenue bonds; FA, federal aid; SA, state aid; U, utility charges; S, special fund, and O, others.

The improvements:

1. Expand city hall on present site. Acquire additional property as necessary, \$250,000, GO.

2. Construct a new corporation yard building and storage facility, \$150,000, GF, U, O.

3. Replace obsolete fire department pumper at the west side station, \$10,000, GF.

4. Add an administrative office to the main fire station building, \$7000, GF.

5. Construct new service building and nursery in Harvey West park, \$5000, GF.

6. Relocate the Cowell beach comfort station, \$20,000, GF.

7. Improve Cowell beach overlook between Dream Inn and the municipal wharf, \$6000, GF.

8. Add classroom and exhibit, laboratory and preparatory

space at the city museum building, \$10,000, GF, O.

9. Relocate wharf restrooms to vicinity of wharf shops, \$8000, GF.

10. Extend wharf along east side to provide additional parking and center traffic lane, \$20,000, O.

11. Construct additional public fishing and parking facilities on wharf, \$75,000, SA, S.

12. Expand commercial area and facilities on wharf, \$10,000, GF.

13. Construct new shop building and lifeguard headquarters on wharf, \$5000, U.

14. Purchase airport property at Skypark in accordance with approved plan of acquisition, \$10,000, GF, SA.

15. Construct new "T" hangars and pave taxiways at airport, \$28,000, GF, SA.

16. Construct new facilities, operations building and revision of existing structures at the sewage treatment plant, \$1,920,000, GO.

17. Construct land section of tunnel outfall from sanitary sewer treatment plant to West Cliff drive, \$1,200,000, G.

18. Construct 54 inch sewer line from Spruce street to treatment plant, \$258,000, GO.

19. Construct sewer line from San Lorenzo boulevard to Seabright avenue, \$59,000, GO.

20. Construct sewer lines across the San Lorenzo river to Buena Vista avenue, \$195,000, GO.

21. Construct sewer lines from Spruce street to Water street to Golf Club drive; from Pacific avenue to Sylvar street and from Front street to the San Lorenzo river, \$319,000, GO.

22. Construct west side sewer from Oxford way to Woodrow avenue, \$14,000, GO.

23. Widen Water street bridge by adding three new lanes, \$310,000, GO.

24. Widen Mission and Water streets from west of Center street to the San Lorenzo river, \$570,000, GO.

25. Construct new bridge over the San Lorenzo river from the foot of Laurel street to San Lorenzo boulevard, \$520,000, GO.

26. Construct connection between Broadway and the Laurel street bridge, \$404,000, GO.

27. Construct easterly extension of Broadway from Darwin street to Frederick street, \$167,000, GO.

28. Widen Soquel avenue to four lanes between Parkway and Capitola road, \$164,000, A, GT.

29. Extend Chestnut street southward from Laurel street to connection with Washington street, \$100,000, GF, GT.

30. Widen Bay street to six lanes from Highway 1 to High street, \$100,000, GF, GT.

31. Install fluorescent lighting along both sides of Pacific avenue, \$14,000, A.

32. Install traffic control signals and intersection lighting at Ocean and Plymouth streets, \$16,000, GF.

33. Install traffic control signals and intersection lighting at Soquel avenue and Frederick street, \$10,000, GF.

34. Schedule water main replacement and improvements in conjunction with street improvements, \$53,000, U.

35. Improve connection with assessment district project (water main installation and replacement) \$30,000, U, A.

36. Improve water main installation in connection with new subdivisions, \$22,000, U.

37. Extend water mains as required to serve new uses, \$45,000, U.

38. Miscellaneous transmission and distribution water main appurtenances, \$6000, U.

39. Install fire hydrants as requested by the fire department and fire districts, \$12,000, U.

40. Install new water services and renewal of existing services, \$50,000, U, A.

41. Purchase water meters required to serve new users, \$20,000, U.

42. Purchase crane, hydraulic hammer, back hoe and pavement breaker for the water department, \$5000, U.

43. Replace approximately 4000 feet of pipeline for Majors creek supply main, \$5000, U.

44. Construct new main branch of library on site of existing main library, \$1,162,000, GO.

45. Acquire site and construct east Santa Cruz branch library, \$239,000, GO.
