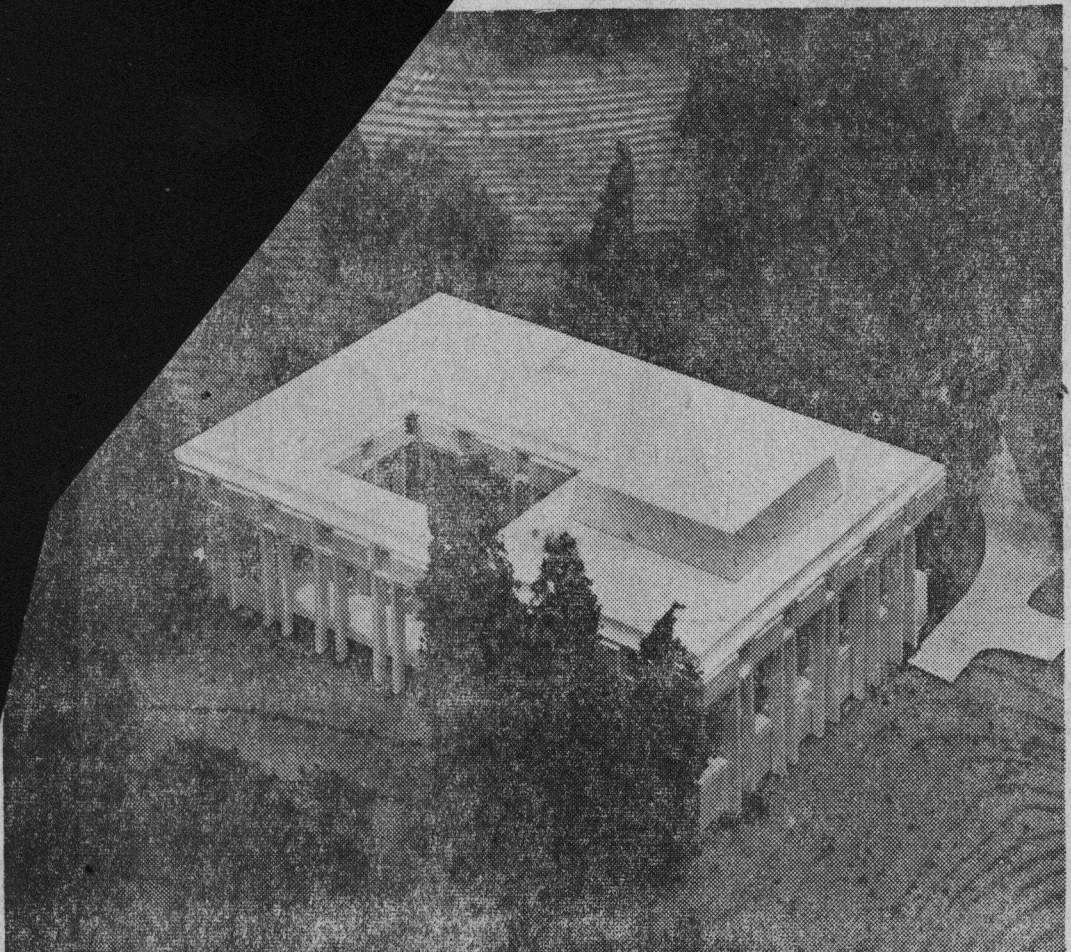


Unit Planned For UCSC



This is a table-top model of Library Unit I for the University of California at Santa Cruz. Drawings for the unit were recently approved by the board of

regents, and work is proceeding on preliminary plans. John Warnecke and Associates are designing the building. It is to be four stories high, with free-

standing exterior columns. Exterior surfaces will be concrete, glass and exposed aggregate. The building is to be completed in 1966.

Regents Approve Drawings For UCSC Library

The first library unit for the University of California at Santa Cruz will be completed by 1966, President Clark Kerr and Chancellor Dean McHenry have announced.

Drawings for the building have been approved and preliminary plans are in progress by John Warnecke and Associates, San Francisco architectural firm.

The main entrance of the building will be to the north, with a view through the glassed-in lobby of redwoods and Monterey bay. On the entrance level will be reference, circulation, reserved book and public catalogue services.

On the ground level below will be the technical processing departments, administrative offices and an audio-visual center. Reading areas on the ground floor will open into an enclosed reading court forming a four-story light well in the center of the building.

Book stacks and reading stations will occupy the second and third floors. Semi-private study alcoves will be formed by the columns on the third floor.

The library unit will have an eventual capacity of 350,000 books

and 1200 reading stations, but part of the building will be used temporarily for offices and classrooms.

The four-story building will cost \$2,368,000.
