Regents Approve Drawings For UCSC Library

The first library unit for the University of California at Santa Cruz will be completed by 1966, President Clark Kerr and Chan-cellor Dean McHenry have announced.

Drawings for the building have been approved and preliminary plans are in progress by John Warnecke and Associates, San Francisco architectural firm.

The main entrance of the building will be to the north, with a view through the glassed-in lobby of redwoods and Monterey bay. On the entrance level will be reference, circulation, reserved book and public catalogue services

On the ground level below will be the technical processing departments, administrative offices and an audio-visual center. Reading areas on the ground floor will to open into an enclosed reading oe- court forming a four-story light well in the center of the building. tions will occupy the second and third floors. Semi-private study alcoves will be formed by the columns on the third floor.

The library unit will have an eventual capacity of 350,000 books
