An ad hoc committee of the Histo Mid-County Historical Society has taken an option to purchase the 86-year-old Martina Castro-Lodge home at 919 Capitola Ave.

The group has indicated it will turn the old mansion over to the Mid-County Historical Society if the club gives its approval for use

as a museum.

The action was revealed this week by Vincent, Leonard. president of the Mid-County Historical Society. He did not reveal the names of the committee members, who took the option on the property, however.

The old house was being offered for sale by the present owners, the Misses Lulu and Julia Lodge, at a reported asking price of \$75,000, through Real Estate Center of Santa Cruz.
