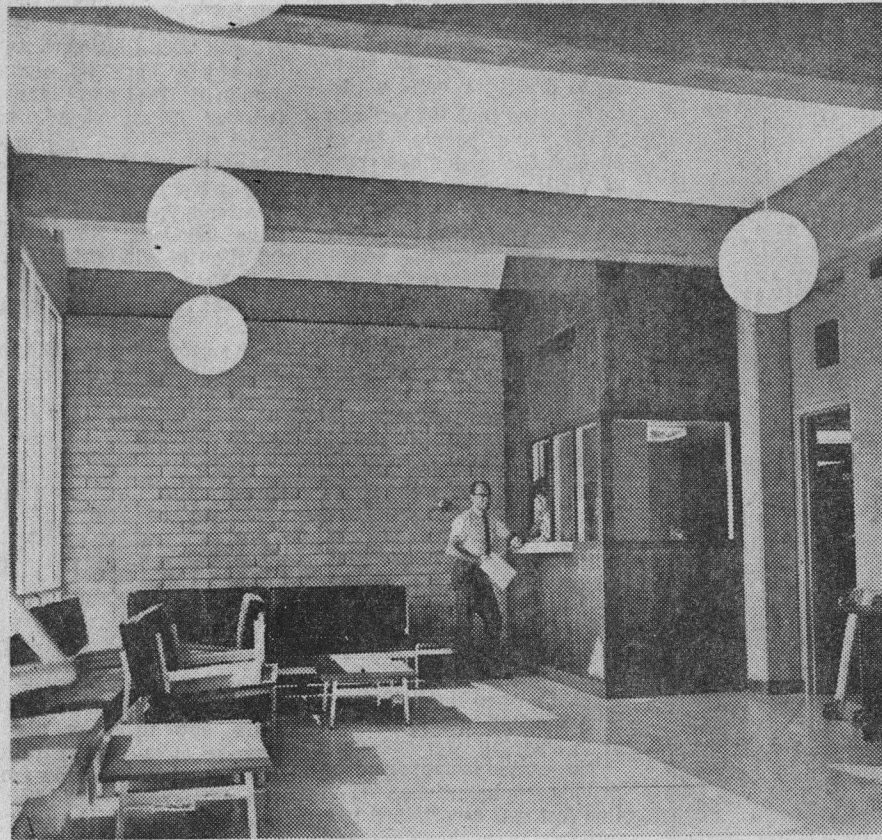


Probation Staff Moves Into New Juvenile Hall
