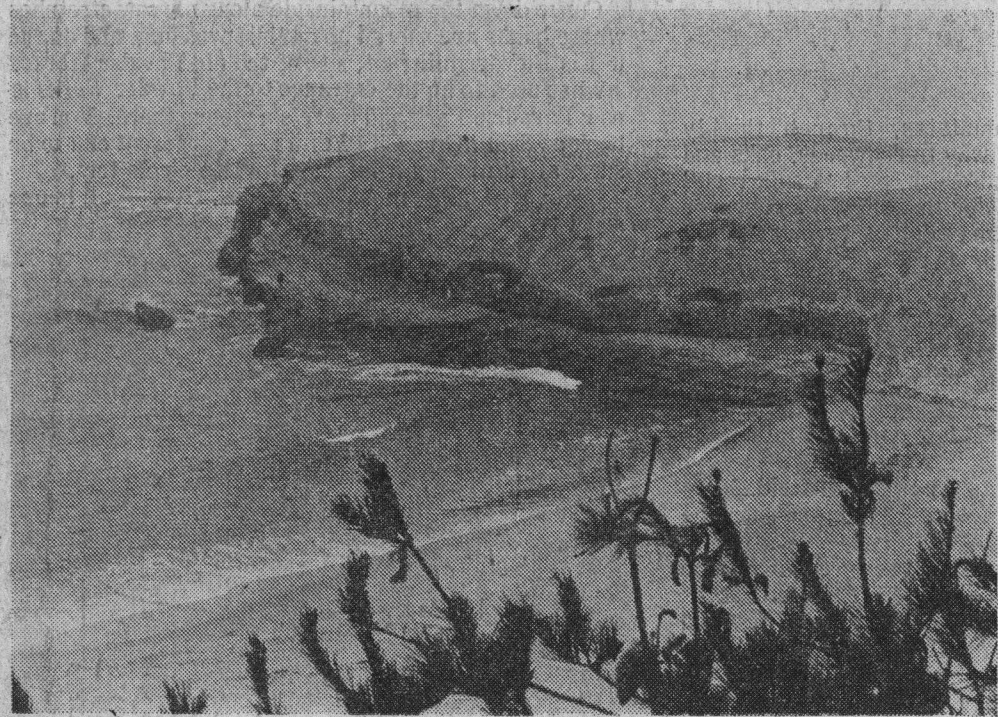
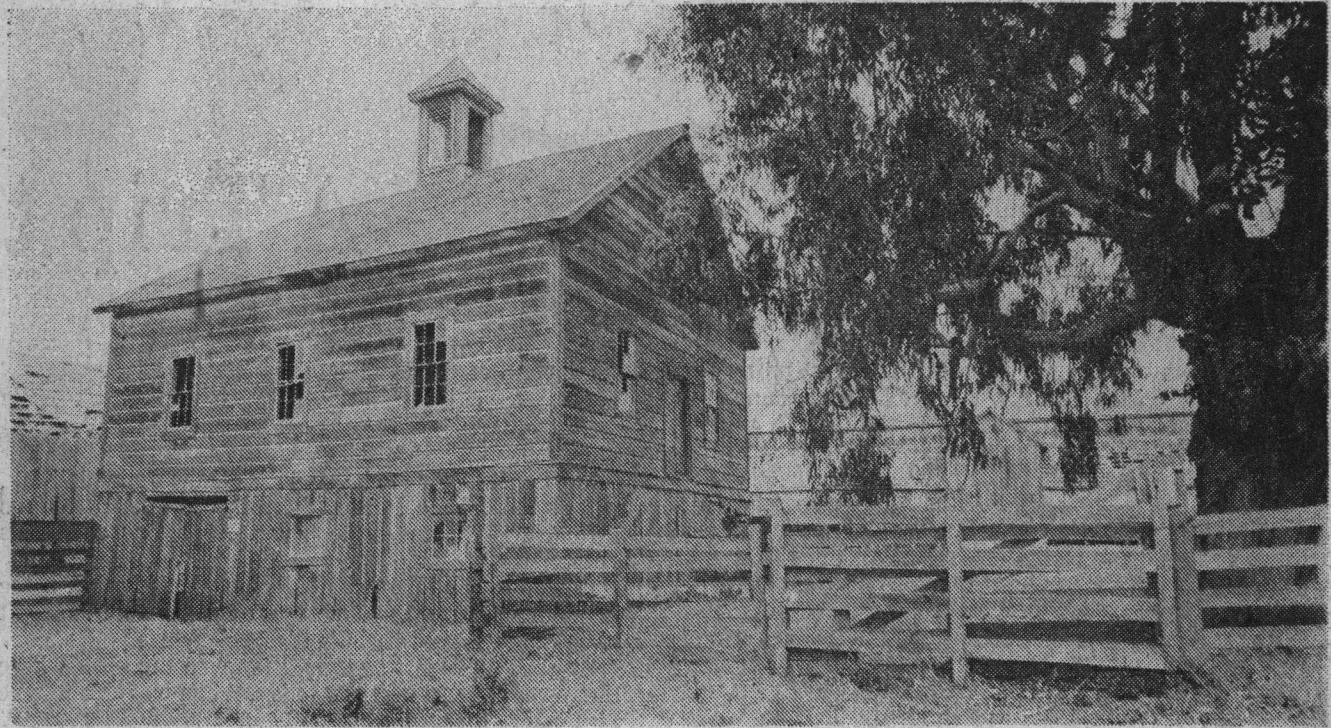


Labor Day... Take a Fun Trip

Old cheese houses and barns whisper in the foggy breeze around Davenport...

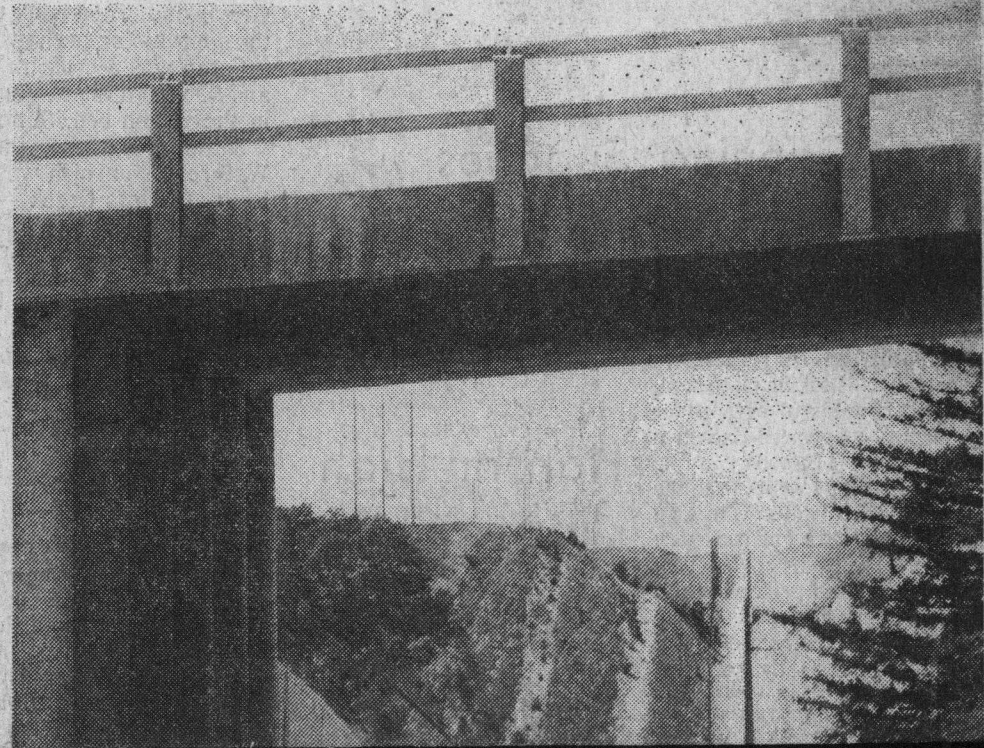

Start at Picture Number One, above left, and "get a piece of the rock" — Greyhound Rock, that is. You might just stop there and have a great day.

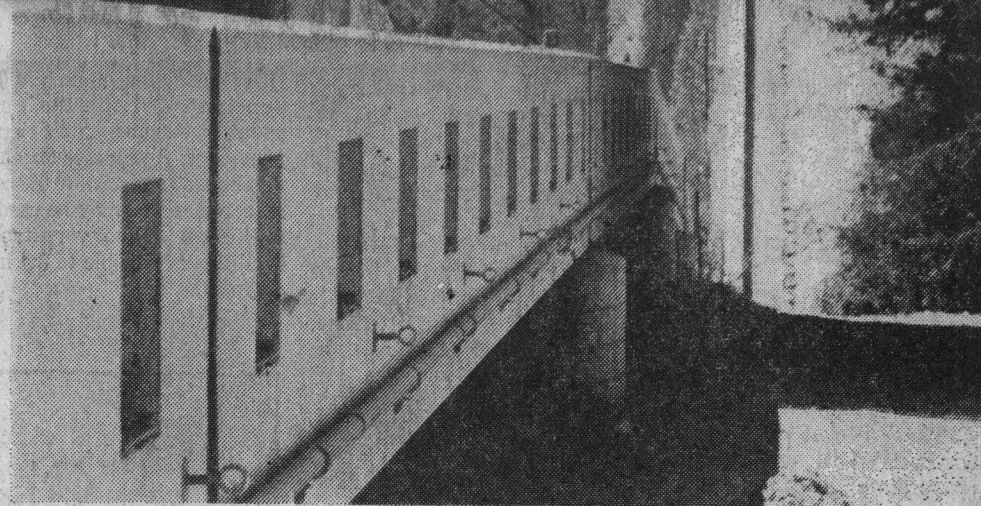
Or you can go on...and on...and on... All we do is suggest. You can choose your own ingredients for your own tour through Santa Cruz County or any part of Santa Cruz County.
