Police Chief Geno Pini said the arrests of Earl Stanley Kuhns, 44, and Richard Anthony Castner, 36, both of San Jose, was based on the fact they were offering for sale "the basest pronography imaginable."

The chief, concerned that the public might fail to realize the kind of material upon which the arrests were based, emphasized:

"The material we seized as evidence is the basest pornographic material made." He said the films and photo magazines and paperback books depict "all kinds of sexual contact between humans, animals and groups."

He said about 10 cartons of allegedly pornographic material was taken into evidence.

Kuhns, co-owner of the store, and Castner, a clerk, were cited in Saturday's arrest and booked in Monday's arrest, Pini said.

"Kuhn said he would be open again Tuesday," the chief added. "We told him we'd be there when he did."
